Truce Report "MANY IRONS IN THE FIRE"

ALLIED AND COMMUNIST NEGOTIATORS HOPE TO COMPROMISE ON THREE DIFFERENCES HOLDING UP TRUCE NEGOTIATIONS. THESE ISSUES ARE TRUCE INSPECTION, TROOP ROTATION AND ISLAND CONTROL.

SATURDAY, RED STAFF OFFICERS REJECTED THE ALLIED PROPOSAL ASKING THAT BOTH SIDES SUBMIT LOCATIONS OF THEIR MILITARY UNITS AFTER AN ARMISTICE IS SIGNED. THEY CLAIMED THAT SUCH A PROPOSAL AMOUNTED TO INTERFERENCE IN THEIR INTERNAL AFFAIRS.

AS FOR INSPECTION TEAMS, THE ALLIES HAVE OFFERED TO REDUCE THEIR DEMANDS ON THE NUMBER OF JOINT JOBSERVER INSPECTION TEAMS FROM 150 TO 10. THE ALLIES ARE WAITING FOR A COMMUNIST ANSWER TO AN ALLIED PROPOSAL MADE THURSDAY, THAT DISCUSSIONS BEGIN NOW ON ITEM FIVE, RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BELLIGERENT COUNTRIES.

THE ALLIES ARE ALSO WAITING FOR THE REDS TO CHOOSE THE THREE NATIONS WHICH WILL REPRESENT THEM ON THE NEUTRAL NATION TROOP SUPERVISORY COMMITTEE.

PRISONER TALKS REMAIN DEARLOCKED. REAR ADMIRAL R.E. LIBBY SAID THE REDS AGAIN REFUSED TO ALLOW NEUTRAL TEAMS TO INTERVIEW CIVILIANS BEHIND THE LINES.

FOREIGNERS IN EGYPT WERE REASSURED YESTERDAY BY EGYPT'S NEW PREMIER, ALY MAHER PASHA, THAT THE GOVERNMENT WILL "SPARE NO EFFORT TO ENSURE THEIR SECURITY AND PROTECT THEIR INTERESTS AND LIBERTIES."

SFC PAT RACIOPPI IS AMONG THE UNFORTUNATES IN THE KOREAN CONFLICT TO RECEIVE BILLS FROM A HOME TOWN FIRM.

WHILE PREPARING A MEAL FOR "EASY" COMPANY "BUFFALOES", RACIOPPI WAS HANDED AN ENVELOPE BY THE MAIL CLERK. ASSUMING IT WAS A LETTER FROM HOME, HE VERY EXCITEDLY OPENED IT ONLY TO FIND IT WAS A STATEMENT FOR TWO DOLLARS FROM HIS HOME TOWN WEEKLY NEWSPAPER.

Stateside News

A PRE-DAWN EXPLOSION 300 FEET UNDERGROUND KILLED SIX MEN EARLY YESTERDAY, SO OTHER MEMBERS OF THE NIGHT SHIFT FOUGHT THEIR WAY TO SAFETY THROUGH CHOKING GAS.

FOUR OF THE 50 WERE HURT BUT ONLY THREE SERIOUSLY ENOUGH TO BE HOSPITALIZED. IT WAS 10 HOURS AFTER THE BLAST BEFORE ALL THE BODIES WERE BROUGHT TO THE SURFACE.

A SPECIAL UNITED NATIONS COMMITTEE IGNORING COMMUNIST CHARGES OF "ATROCITIES" TURNED DOWN SATURDAY A RUSSIAN PROPOSAL THAT THE UN INTERVENE IN THE KOREAN PEACE TALKS.

INSTEAD, THE COMMITTEE APPROVED A WESTERN ALLIED PROPOSAL TO CALL A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AFTER AN ARMISTICE HAS BEEN REACHED OR, IF THERE IS NEED FOR ADDITIONAL UN MILITARY ACTION AGAINST THE REDS.

RUSSIA FOUGHT BITTERLY TO FORCE IMMEDIATE INTERVENTION TO END THE KOREAN WAR.

THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IS GOING TO TRY TO END THE STRIKE OF 16,000 AF OF E TRUCK DRIVERS. THE STRIKE HAS TIED UP HIGHWAY TRUCKING IN 12 SOUTHERN AND MIDWEST STATES. THE FEDERAL MEDIATION CHIEF, CYRUS CHING, HAS ASKED FOR PEACE MEETINGS TO BEGIN TODAY.

A JURY HAS BEEN PICKED IN THE LOS ANGELES TRIAL OF 15 "SECOND-STRING" COMMUNIST PARTY LEADERS. THEY ARE CHARGED WITH CONSPIRING TO TEACH AND ADVOCATE THE VIOLENT OVERTHROW OF THE US GOVERNMENT.

EIGHT WOMEN AND FOUR MEN WERE CHOSEN FOR THE JURY.

BRUTUS HAMILTON, DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, YESTERDAY WAS NAMED HEAD COACH OF THE 1952 US OLYMPIC'S MEN'S TRACK AND FIELD TEAM.....
