**TRUCE REPORT**

YESTERDAY ALLIED AND RED STAFF OFFICERS BEGAN WORK ON FINAL PRISONER EXCHANGE TERMS.

WEDNESDAY THE NEGOTIATORS REACHED "SUBSTANTIAL ACCORD" ON ALL BUT THE MAIN ISSUES. STILL UNSETTLED IS THE ALLIED PROPOSAL FOR VOLUNTARY REPATRIATION GIVING PRISONERS A CHANCE TO DECIDE WHETHER TO GO HOME OF THEIR OWN FREE WILL. THE COMMUNISTS ARE HOLDING OUT FOR FORCED REPATRIATION.

STAFF OFFICERS HAVE AGREED TO BYPASS THIS MAJOR POINT FOR A WHILE WHEN THEY START THE FINAL DRAFT OF AN 11-POINT ALLIED EXCHANGE PLAN.

THE MAIN SESSION WAS IN RECESS YESTERDAY ON THE FINAL AGENDA ITEM, RECOMMENDATIONS TO GOVERNMENTS. THERE STILL IS NO INDICATION OF WHEN IT WILL MEET AGAIN.

THE COMMUNIST CHINESE AND NORTH KOREAN DELEGATIONS ASKED FOR A RECESS THURSDAY. THEY WANTED TIME TO REVISE THEIR THREE-POINT PROPOSAL. IT PROVIDED FOR A HIGH LEVEL CONFERENCE TO CONSIDER WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN TROOPS FROM KOREA AFTER AN ARMISTICE, SETTLEMENT OF THE KOREAN PEACE AND OTHER QUESTIONS ABOUT ASIA.

THE ALLIES OBJECTED TO INCLUDING THE PROBLEMS OF ALL ASIA IN A KOREAN PEACE SETTLEMENT.

**UMT: To Be Or Not To Be?**

SLASHING ATTACKS ON UNIVERSAL MILITARY TRAINING BY LEADERS OF CHURCH GROUPS HAVE LEFT SENATOR RICHARD RUSSEL, AS HE PUTS IT, "FRANKLY PUZZLED."

THE GEORGIA DEMOCRAT IS CHAIRMAN OF THE SENATE ARMED SERVICES COMMITTEE WHICH HAS BEEN LOOKING INTO DETAILS OF UMT. MOST CHURCH UNITS BITTERLY ASSAILED THE PROPOSAL TO COMPEL 18-YEAR-OLDS TO TAKE SIX MONTHS BASIC TRAINING, BUT SAY THEY ARE WILLING TO GO ALONG WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE DRAFTS FOR SEVERAL YEARS MORE.

RUSSEL, ON THE OTHER HAND, IS LOOKING FOR UMT TO EVENTUALLY REPLACE THE DRAFT, BY BUILDING UP A VAST RESERVOIR OF TRAINED MANPOWER IN THE RESERVES.
