



## WORK THRU ATTACK

FIVE COMM. MEN GUARDED BY TWO MEMBERS OF THE I&R PLATOON RECENTLY RAN 2500 METERS OF WIRE TO FIND A BREAK DURING A 97 MINUTE CHINESE ATTACK.

A WIRING DEFECT IN THE THIRD BATTALION MADE COMMUNICATION DIFFICULT. CPL. CECIL L. LANCASTER RECEIVED THE ASSIGNMENT TO LOCATE THE FAULTY WIRE. HE VOLUNTEERED TO WALK TO THE BATTALION IN THE AFTER-NOON, BUT DUE TO ENEMY OBSERVATION THIS WAS IMPOSSIBLE.

LANCASTER CHOSE THE FOUR MEN TO ASSIST HIM AND SHORTLY AFTER DARK BEGAN THE SEVEN-HOUR TASK.

THE "BUFFALO" CREW WERE WORKING IN THE LONELY QUIET OF THE NIGHT WHEN SUDDENLY THE DISTANT BLAST OF A BUGLE BROKE THE STILLNESS. HAVING HEARD THIS WEIRD SOUND BEFORE, THE WIREMEN KNEW THEY MUST HURRY TO COMPLETE THEIR JOB FOR AN ENEMY ATTACK WOULD SOON BE IN THE MAKING.

THE MEN WORKED FEVERISHLY AND AT 01.30 A LARGE FORCE OF COMMUNIST TROOPS CHARGED THE THIRD BATTALION POSITIONS. THE SKY WAS SOON FILLED WITH SCARLET RAYS OF ARTILLERY FLASHES AND TRACERS ETCHED BRIGHT PATHS IN THE EARLY MORNING DARKNESS. STILL THE "BUFFALO" WIREMEN CONTINUED, NEVER FALTERING, BUT JUMPING IN READINESS AT EACH SHADOW AND DISTURBANCE OF THE WIRE.

"SEVERAL TIMES WE THOUGHT THE SHADOWS WERE INFILTRATORS," SAID LANCASTER, "BUT WE KNEW WE MUST REPAIR THE BREAK." FINALLY, AT 0300 HOURS, THE BREAK WAS LOCATED. HURRIEDLY THE BREAK WAS SPLICED AND AGAIN COMMUNICATIONS WERE IN CONTACT.

LANCASTER AND HIS BRAVE LITTLE GROUP FACILITATED A DECISIVE DEFEAT HANDED THE REDS.

## UNC ACCEPTS RED CONFERENCE BID

THE MAIN KOREAN ARMISTICE DELEGATION MET YESTERDAY MORNING FOR 18 MINUTES, THEN RECESSED FOR 40-MINUTES UNTIL 1100.

THE UNC ACCEPTED THE RED PROPOSAL FOR A POST ARMISTICE PEACE CONFERENCE LEAVING IT UP TO THE DIPLOMATS TO RESTRICT THE TALKS TO KOREAN MATTERS ONLY.

IN A STAFF OFFICER MEETING THE COMMUNISTS DEMANDED THAT SOVIET-RUSSIA BE INCLUDED AMONG NEUTRAL NATION ARMISTICE OBSERVERS. THE DISPUTE DEVELOPED SUNDAY WHEN THE REDS PROPOSED RUSSIA, CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND POLAND TO MATCH THE THREE ALLIED-PROPOSED NEUTRALS, SWITZERLAND, SWEDEN AND NORWAY.

ALLIED NEGOTIATORS AGREED TO POLAND AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BUT COL. DON O. DARROW, CHIEF UN STAFF OFFICER, IMMEDIATELY REJECTED RUSSIA AS "NOT ACCEPTABLE."

## NEW COUGAR FIGHTER

THE NAVY DEPARTMENT HAS DISCLOSED SOME INFORMATION ABOUT A NEW DEFENSE WEAPON. ITS THE NEW GRUMMAN COUGAR JET FIGHTER WHICH THE NAVY SAYS IS MUCH FASTER THAN THE PANTHER NOW BEING USED BY THE NAVY AND MARINE FLYERS IN KOREA.
