



NOCTURNAL SERENADE

MEN OF "A" COMPANY, DIDN'T HAVE TO GO FAR RECENTLY TO BE ENTERTAINED BY A NORTH KOREAN "JAM SESSION."

SGT. GERALD J. BATLON AND HIS SIX-MAN LISTENING POST WERE ALL ALONE ON A FINGER SEVERAL HUNDRED YARDS IN FRONT OF THE COMPANY PATIENTLY AWAITING SIGN OF ENEMY ACTIVITY. IN THE LATE HOURS OF DARKNESS SMALL GROUPS OF NORTH KOREANS WERE HEARD ON A SLOPE 400 YARDS TO THEIR FRONT.

RAPIDLY THE ACTIVITY INCREASED. "THEY WERE RUNNING AROUND AND TALKING LOUDLY," SAID BATLON. THE CLANG OF SHOVELS WAS VERY PROMINENT AND THE NEXT MORNING WE COULD SEE THE BUNKERS THEY WERE BUILDING."

SEVERAL TIMES A SMALL GROUP WOULD WANDER NEAR THE LP AND THE "BUFFALOES" ANTICIPATED TROUBLE, BUT THEY ALWAYS TURNED BACK. WHEN THE FEDS THOUGHT EVERYBODY WAS SETTLED DOWN FOR THE NIGHT, THEY BEGAN SINGING THEIR NATIONAL ANTHEM. "A-HE-YO."

"THEY SANG MOST OF THE NIGHT," SAID BATLON. "AND WE JUST RELAXED AND ABSORBED THE MUSIC. I ONLY WISH THEY WOULD SERENADE US ALL THE TIME," HE ADDED EMPHATICALLY.

THE CIO-UNITED STEEL WORKERS HAVE POSTPONED THEIR STRIKE DEADLINE AGAINST THE STEEL INDUSTRY FOR ANOTHER MONTH TO GIVE THE WAGE STABILIZATION BOARD TIME TO MAKE ITS RECOMMENDATION FOR A FAIR AND EQUITABLE SETTLEMENT. THE STRIKE NOW IS SET FOR MARCH 23.

PHILLIP HUGHES OF THE SELECT BUREAU TOLD THE HOUSE VETERANS COMMITTEE THAT MOST AMERICAN YOUNG MEN, NOW AND FOR A LONG TIME TO COME, CAN EXPECT TO SERVE IN THE ARMED FORCES. THIS TESTIMONY WAS GIVEN AS THE COMMITTEE CONSIDERED EXTENDING GI BENEFITS TO KOREAN VETERANS. HUGHES SAYS THE ADMINISTRATION FAVORS THESE PROPOSALS.

UNC REFUSES "NEUTRAL" RUSSIA

COMMUNIST DEMANDS FOR RUSSIAN PARTICIPATION IN THE KOREAN ARMISTICE TALKS REMAINED A MAJOR STUMBLING BLOCK YESTERDAY.

THURSDAY THE ALLIES ELABORATED ON THEIR REFUSAL TO ACCEPT RUSSIA AS A "NEUTRAL" NATION TO PARTICIPATE IN ARMISTICE SUPERVISION. THE ALLIED OBJECTION IS BASED ON THE FACT THE USSR ADJOINS NORTHWEST KOREA AND HAS PARTICIPATED IN THAT COUNTRY'S AFFAIRS.

THE WARNING ABOUT RUSSIA'S DECISIVE ROLE IN REE MOVES AT THE PANMUNJOM TALKS WAS AIDED BY THE VOICE OF THE UNITED NATIONS COMMAND. AN UNOFFICIAL RADIO PROGRAM. THE BROADCAST CAUTIONED AGAINST OPTIMISM OVER THE AGREEMENT REACHED TUESDAY ON ITEM FIVE.

THE BROADCASTING THAT A POST-ARMISTICE PEACE CONFERENCE BE HELD BY THE NATIONS WITH TROOPS IN KOREA. THE BROADCAST SAID THAT COMMUNIST TACTICS SEEM TO BE "TO RAISE TWO ADDITIONAL DISPUTES TO TAKE THE PLACE OF EVERY ONE THAT HAS BEEN SETTLED." IT ADDED THAT EVERY ADVANCE BEING FOLLOWED BY "A BACKWARD STEP UNTIL MOSCOW DECIDES IT WANTS PEACE."

EIGHTY JAPANESE WAR BRIDES GOT THEIR FIRST IMPRESSIONS OF THE UNITED STATES YESTERDAY. THEY ARE WAITING PROCESSING WITH THEIR HUSBANDS AT CAMP STONEMAN, CALIFORNIA. THE GROUP ARRIVED FROM THE FAR EAST THURSDAY. IT IS THE LARGEST CONTINGENT OF JAPANESE WAR BRIDES YET TO ARRIVE.

SAF SAN FRANCISCO HAD "THE GREATEST TRAFFIC JAM IN HISTORY" YESTERDAY AS A STRIKE OF CITY TRANSIT EMPLOYEES WENT INTO ITS SECOND DAY. THE TRANSIT SYSTEM HAD 275,000 DAILY RIDERS.
