BUNKER BIRDIES

THREE "BUFFALO" RIFLEMEN BECAME NATURE LOVERS RECENTLY AND ARE NOW HOUSING A PAIR OF BIRDS AND FOUR EGGS IN THEIR BUNKER.

CPL TROY S. SAVAGE RECEIVED TWO VISITORS IN HIS BUNKER SEVERAL DAYS AFTER COMPLETING THE ENPLACEMENT. THE VISITORS WERE TWO BLUE-COLORED KOREAN SWALLOWS. THEIR VISITS BECAME MORE REGULAR AS THEY LOST ALL FEAR OF THE "CHARLIE" COMPANY OCCUPANTS.

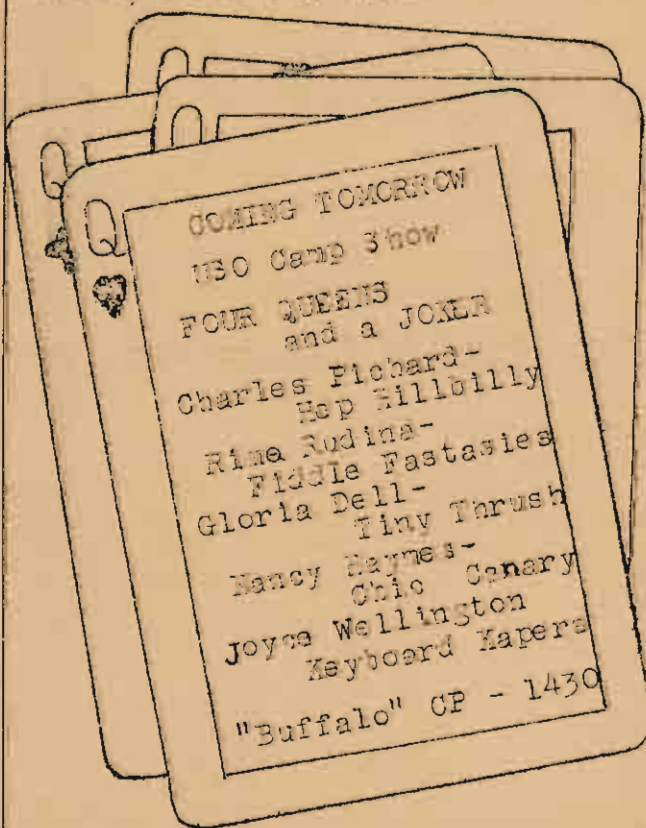

POW DISCUSSION

COMMUNIST ARMISTICE NEGOTIATORS HAVE TRIED TO COUNTER AN ALLIED DEMAND FOR INFORMATION ON ALLIED PRISONERS NOT ON COMMUNIST PRISONER OF WAR LISTS.

AN ALLIED SPOKESMAN SAID YESTERDAY THE REDS HANDED AN ALLIED LIASON OFFICER A NOTE ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE UN COMMANDANT'S DEMAND FOR INFORMATION. AT THE SAME TIME, THE COMMUNISTS ASKED THE UN COMMAND WHAT HAD HAPPENED TO SOME 1,000 COMMUNIST PRISONERS WHO HAD BEEN LISTED ON A DECEMBER LIST AND NOT ON A REVISED LIST SEVERAL WEEKS LATER. UN NEGOTIATORS HAD PREVIOUSLY EXPLAINED TO THE REDS THAT THE DIFFERENCE LAID IN THE DUPLICATION OF NAMES AND IN POW'S GIVING FALSE NAMES WHEN THEY WERE CAPTURED.

IKE STARTS CAMPAIGN

GENERAL EISENHOWER SPOKE AS A POLITICAL CANDIDATE YESTERDAY AT A RALLY IN HIS HOMETOWN, ABILENE, KANSAS. HE TOLD THE CHEERING THOUSANDS THAT ANY POLITICAL PARTY THAT HAS BEEN IN POWER FOR A LONG TIME BECOMES CORRUPT AND FOR THAT REASON THE PEOPLE SHOULD END WHAT HE CALLED EXTERNAL AND INTERNAL DANGERS FACING THE UNITED STATES.

HE POINTED TO "THE IMPLACABLE HOSTILITIES OF THE POWERFUL COMMUNIST DICTATORSHIP" AND WARNED THAT IF THE REDS SUCCEEDED IN DOMINATING THE WORLD, THEY COULD CUT AMERICA FROM NEEDED RAW MATERIALS.

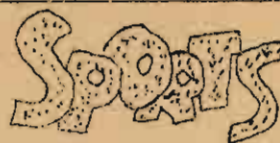
HE ASKED FOR AN END TO THE SECRECY SURROUNDING FOREIGN RELATIONS. HE SAID FOREIGN FEELINGS MUST BE MADE PUBLIC TO GAIN "INTELLIGENT SUPPORT" FROM THE AMERICAN PEOPLE AND PREVENT FURTHER DIPLOMATIC SETBACKS LIKE THAT AT YALTA.

GENERAL EISENHOWER SPOKE OF THE BILLIONS ALREADY SPENT IN BUILDING OUR ALLIES UP MILITARILY AND ECONOMICALLY. HE SAID HE FAVORED THIS SUPPORT BUT PROMISED THE COST WOULD SOON DECREASE.

DOMESTICALLY, THE RETIRED FIVE-STAR GENERAL CALLED FOR GREATER UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN CAPITAL AND LABOR. HE SAID THE PROSPERITY OF ALL CLASSES IS ESSENTIAL TO A PROSPEROUS NATION.

HE ALSO ATTACKED EXCESSIVE TAXATION AND GOVERNMENT SPENDING, AND CHARGED THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT WITH TAKING OVER FUNCTIONS THAT BELONG TO LOCAL COMMUNITIES.

THE LATEST REPORTS FROM THE SOUTH DAKOTA PRIMARY SHOW SENATOR TAFT LEADING GENERAL EISENHOWER BY SOME 550 VOTES. WITH NINE THOUSAND VOTES STILL TO BE COUNTED, THE SENATOR HAS 64,600, AND THE GENERAL 64,050.



HOOT EVERS AND GEORGE KELL, OBTAINED FROM DETROIT TUESDAY, BOTH HOMERED WEDNESDAY AS THE BOSTON RED SOX DEFEATED THE CLEVELAND INDIANS 13-11 IN A SLUGFEST. THE VICTORY EASED THE SOX BACK INTO FIRST PLACE IN THE AMERICAN LEAGUE, THREE PERCENTAGE POINTS AHEAD OF THE INDIANS. DIZZY TROUT, ALSO OBTAINED FROM THE TIGERS IN THE TRADE, FINISHED UP FOR THE RED SOX AFTER MEL PARNELL WAS KNOCKED OUT OF THE BOX.
