

COMMEMORATIVE ADDRESS

EIGHT YEARS AGO THE FIGHTH U.S. ARMY WAS BORN AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE UNITED STATES AF ED FORCES. HISTORY CHEMICLES THE FACT THAT THE FIGHTH ARMY WAS DESTINED TO BE A FRIMARY BULWARK AGAINST COMMUNIST AGGRESSION, FOR MEARLY TWO YEARS CUR ALMY H.S. FOUCHT ALONG THE COMMUNIST FRONTIER IN THE FAR EAST AND DUDING THAT TIME, TOGETHER WITH OUR UNITED DATIONS ALLIES, HAVE ACCOMPLISHED WE, OUR AS THE EIGHTH U.S. ADMY COMMANDER, I EXTEND TO THE PERSONNEL OF

THE COMMAND SINCERE COMMENT TION FOR A JOB MACHIFICENTLY EXECUTED, I REITERATE MY HOPE FOR AN HOLDRAPLE PLACE HOVEVER, IN EVENT OF ANY MOVE BY THE ASCLESS I HAVE OF PLETE CONFIDENCE AND UN-BOUNED FAITH IN COURSE AND CAPISILITIES OF YOU WHO SERVE YOUR COUNTRY IN A MOST DIFFICULT MISSION.

ACTION AT KOJE

AMERICAN PARATROOPERS YESTER-DAY BROKE INTO MANY PRISON COM-POUNDE ON KOJE ISLAND. THE PAPA-TROOPERS STORMED COMPCHID 76 AFTER THE PRISONERS IGNORED DADEAS INT) ASSEMBLE AND PREPARE TO MOVE NEW COMPOUNDS, THE BATTLE WITH THE REDS LASTED FOR OVER TWO AND ONE HALF HOULS.

AT LEAST 100 PHISONERS WERE TREATED FOR WOUNDS, AND TO COM-MUNISTS AND ONE AMERICAN SOLDIER WERE KILLED. MANY OF THE RED CAS-UALTIES TERE INFLICTED BY COMMINIE FANAFICS TRYING TO STOP DILLA COM-1 PHISOMET'S FROM SUBSEMDERING.

LATER IN THE DAY, NEDS [1] NEARBY COMPOUND 78 MEEKLY OF DETS AND BEGAN MOVING OUT TO HEW, PREE THO LOGS. OBEYED 500-MAN COMPOUNDS, THE SIX THOU-SAND PRISOLERS IN THIS COMPOUND WERE OBVIOUSLY GWAYET BY THE SHOW OF FORCE IN COMPOUND 76.
