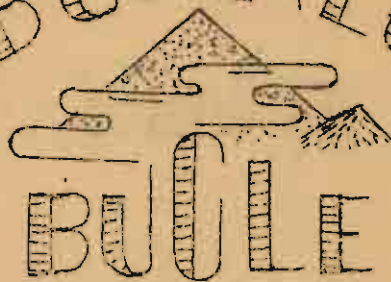
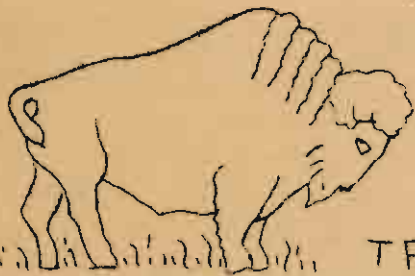

TALENTED AMATEUR WRESTLER JOINS 17th

PFC BILL NARDINI, ONE TIME GREAT IN THE AMATEUR WRESTLING WORLD IS NOW WITH THE 17TH MEDICAL DETACHMENT. PFC NARDINI WAS A MEMBER OF THE NOTED CORNELL OF IOWA WRESTLING TEAM AND HOLDS SEVERAL INDIVIDUAL TITLES.

PEAK YEAR FOR NARDINI WAS IN 1951 WHEN HE WENT THE FULL SEASON IN THE 165 POUND WEIGHT CLASS WITH ONLY ONE DEFEAT. THAT DEFEAT WAS AT THE NATIONAL AAU SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP MATCHES HELD AT CEDAR FALLS, IOWA BY BILL SMITH OF IOWA STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE. IN A LATER BOUT NARDINI HAD THE SATISFACTION OF DOWNING HIS OLD OPPONENT OF THE NAAU.

EARLIER IN HIS WRESTLING CAREER, NARDINI CAME OUT FOURTH IN THE NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIP MATCHES OF 1949.

HE HAD ONLY ONE YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL WRESTLING AT CRANE TECH IN CHICAGO, ILL., BEFORE GOING INTO THE VARSITY COMPETITION. DURING HIS TWO YEARS OF COLLEGIATE WRESTLING HE EARNED A NAME AMONG THE TOP AMATEUR WRESTLERS, GRAPPLING WITH MANY OLYMPIC CONTENDERS. BECAUSE HE WAS IN THE ARMY, HE DID NOT HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS YEAR'S OLYMPIC TRYOUTS.

CORNELL COLLEGE BECAME FAMOUS IN 1917 WHEN THE SMALL MIDWEST COLLEGE TEAM UPSET SCORES OF EASTERN, SOUTHERN AND MIDWEST UNIVERSITY WRESTLING SQUADS. IN THAT SAME YEAR THEY RAN AWAY WITH THE TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP OF BOTH THE NCAA AND THE NAAU MATCHES:

NARDINI GRADUATED FROM CORNELL AUGUST 1951. HE ENTERED THE ARMY UPON HIS GRADUATION AND JUST ARRIVED IN KOREA WHERE HE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED TO THE 17TH MEDICAL DETACHMENT.

CLARK DEFINES POLICY

GENERAL MARK CLARK SAYS THE UN COMMAND NEGOTIATORS WILL MEET WITH THE REDS WHEN THEY HAVE A NEW PROPOSAL WHICH OFFERS THE POSSIBILITY OF SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS TOWARDS AN ARMISTICE. THE UN COMMANDER REPLIED YESTERDAY MORNING TO A MESSAGE FROM THE COMMUNIST HIGH COMMAND PROTESTING THE THREE DAY RECESS CALLED BY THE UNITED NATIONS SATURDAY.

THE REPLY WAS HANDED TO A COMMUNIST LIAISON OFFICER SHORTLY BEFORE 11 YESTERDAY MORNING AT PANMUNJOM.

THE GENERAL SAID THERE IS NO UNDERSTANDING REQUIRING DAILY MEETINGS. HE POINTED OUT THAT THE UN DELEGATION HAS ENDURED COMMUNIST CHARGES FOR MONTHS. THE CHARGES, HE SAID, WERE BASED ON DISTORTIONS AND HALF TRUTHS AND WERE PRESENTED AT ARMISTICE SESSIONS FOR PROPAGANDA PURPOSES.

GENERAL CLARK COMMENDED THE ALLIED DELEGATION FOR COMMENDABLE PATIENCE. HE TOLD THE RED LEADERS THAT HE FULLY APPROVES THE WAY IN WHICH THE UN DELEGATES HAVE CONDUCTED NEGOTIATIONS.

HE SAID THE DELEGATION WOULD ALSO BE AVAILABLE TO EXAMINE WITH THE REDS ANY HONORABLE MEANS TO INSURE THAT NO PRISONERS FROM EITHER SIDE IS FORCEABLY REPATRIATED AGAINST HIS FREELY EXPRESSED WISHES.

GENERAL DOUGLAS MACARTHUR HAS BEEN CHOSEN AS THE KEYNOTE SPEAKER FOR THE REPUBLICAN NATIONAL CONVENTION OPENING IN CHICAGO JULY 7. THE CONVENTION ARRANGEMENTS COMMITTEE NAMED GENERAL MACARTHUR BY A VOICE VOTE AFTER HIS NAME WAS THE ONLY ONE PLACED IN NOMINATION.

REPRESENTATIVE JOSEPH MARTIN OF MASSACHUSETTS WAS RECOMMENDED FOR THE PERMANENT CHAIRMANSHIP FOR HIS FOURTH CONSECUTIVE TIME.

PANMUNJOM TALKS RECOMMENCED YESTERDAY MORNING. NO PROGRESS WAS REPORTED. ANOTHER MEETING TODAY.

WORLD NEWS

PRESIDENT TRUMAN HAS APPEALED TO CONGRESS FOR POWER TO SEIZE THE STEEL INDUSTRY. BUT THE SENATE HAS INDICATED IT WILL NOT APPROVE THE PRESIDENT'S REQUEST UNTIL HE USES THE TAFT-HARTLEY LAW TO STOP THE STRIKE IN THE MILLS.

THE UPPER CHAMBER YESTERDAY MORNING DEFEATED AN AMMENDMENT TO TAX SEIZURE PROVISIONS INTO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE LAW. THE VOTE WAS 52-28. EARLIER THE SENATE REJECTED A DEFENSE PRODUCTION ACT AMMENDMENT BY SENATOR MAYSBANK TO FREEZE WAGES AND ALLOW THE OWNERS TO COLLECT COMPENSATION FOR DAMAGE TO THEIR PROPERTY WHILE IN GOVERNMENT HANDS.

A RUSSIAN SOLDIER AND A COMMUNIST POLICEMAN KIDNAPPED TWO WEST GERMAN'S PRESS ASSOCIATION CORRESPONDENTS FROM THE BRITISH SECTOR OF BERLIN TUESDAY NIGHT. SHORTLY AFTER THE KIDNAPPING, ALLIED AUTHORITIES ANNOUNCED RECEIPT OF A NOTE FROM THE RUSSIANS SAYING ALLIED MILITARY POLICE PATROLS WILL BE BARRED FROM THE SUPER HIGHWAY LEADING TO WESTERN GERMANY. SOVIET GENERAL VASSLY CHUIKOV SAID IN THE LATEST RED NOTE THAT ALLIED PATROLS WERE "GROUNDLESS."

THE AMERICAN SUPERLINER USS UNITED STATES TUESDAY ESTABLISHED A WORLD SPEED RECORD OF MORE THAN 34 KNOTS. US MARITIME ADMINISTRATION OFFICIALS SAID THE RECORD WAS ESTABLISHED TUESDAY AS THE 53,000 TON VESSEL PLOWED THROUGH THE ATLANTIC OCEAN ON AN EIGHT HOUR HIGH SPEED ENDURANCE TEST OFF THE VIRGINIA COAST.

COMMUNIST INFANTRYMEN INCREASED THEIR PROBES ALONG THE EIGHTH ARMY FRONT TUESDAY BUT ALLIED TROOPS REPULSED THE ADVANCES AND SENT RAIDING PARTIES INTO RED TERRITORY.

MARTY MARION, VETERAN SHORT-STOP-GOACH, WAS NAMED TO REPLACE THE STORMY HORNSBY.

VEECK ANNOUNCED THAT HORNSBY WAS BEING REPLACED "FOR THE GOOD OF THE TEAM." HORNSBY TRACED HIS DISCHARGE TO AN INCIDENT IN NEW YORK LAST WEEK IN WHICH VEECK, LISTENING TO THE BROWNS-YANKEES GAME ON THE RADIO IN ST LOUIS, TELEPHONED AND ORDERED THE GAME PLAYED UNDER PROTEST ALTHOUGH HORNSBY HAD NOT PROTESTED.

IT WAS THE SECOND TIME IN HIS CAREER THAT HORNSBY HAD BEEN REPLACED AS MANAGER OF THE BROWNS AT VARIOUS TIMES; HORNSBY MANAGED THE CARDS, CUBS AND BRAVES.

MARION WILL SERVE AS PLAYER-MANAGER THIS YEAR, THEN STRICTLY AS MANAGER IN THE NEXT TWO SEASONS.

BRITAIN AND FRANCE WOULD HAVE SCALED THEIR MILITARY SERVICES DOWN TO 500,000 EACH TO BALANCE THE SCALE BETWEEN EAST AND WEST.
