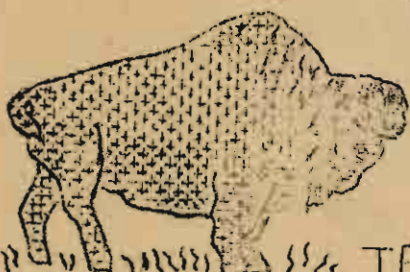

## KOJE UNDER CONTROL

BRIG GEN HAYDON BOATNER AP-PEARS TO HAVE WON THE BATTLE FOR UNCONTESTED CONTROL OF KOJE ISLAND.

FOUR TOUGH COMPOUNDS, TERRORIZED BY COMMUNIST LEADERS, SURRENDERED TO THE CAMP COMMANDANT AUTHORITIES YESTERDAY. GENERAL BOATNER SAID: "THE WORST IS OVER! TWO OF THE COMPOUNDS WERE CLEARED WITHOUT RESISTENCE, ANOTHER SENT WORD IT WAS READY TO OBEY THE GENERAL'S ORDERS AND A FOURTH SURRENDERED 21 ANTI-COMMUNIST PRISONERS. GENERAL BOATNER SAYS: HE WILL NOT GO SO FAR AS TO SAY RESISTANCE HAS ENDED BUT HE DECLARES, IT IS DEFINATLY "ON THE EBB."

THE COMMANDANT SAYS HE PLANS NO MORE TRANSFERS OF INMATE'S FOR THE NEXT TWO OT THREE DAYS. SINCE TUESDAY, MORE THAN 27,000 PRISONERS IN SIX OF KOJE'S 17 COMPOUNDS, HAVE EITHER BEEN SHIFTED TO OTHER LARGE INCLOSURES OR BROKEN UP INTO NEW, SMALL AND MORE MANAGEABLE STOCKADES HOLDING 500 MEN EACH.

THE GENERAL PLANS TO DIVIDE MORE OF THE LARGE COMPOUNDS INTO SMALLER ONES AND MOVE 30,000 PRISONERS OFF KOJE TO OTHER ISLANDS.

TRUCE DELEGATES MET FOR 27 MINUTES YESTERDAY AND WILL MEET AGAIN TODAY AT 11 AM, AT THE COMMUNIST'S INSISTENCE. NO PROGRESS WAS REPORTED.

## NEWS FLASHES

THE BRITISH LABOR PARTY EXECUTIVE COUNCIL AGAIN HAS CALLED FOR THE ADMISSION OF COMMUNIST CHINA INTO THE UNITED NATIONS.

MOSCOW HAS ANNOUNCED THAT FORMER SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED STATES, ALEXANDER PANYUSHKIN, HAS A NEW JOB AS AMBASSADOR TO COMMUNIST CHINA. PANYUSHKIN IS ON HIS WAY HOME NOW FROM WASHINGTON.

GENERAL EISENHOWER HAS MADE IT PLAIN THAT HE WILL CLEAN OUT THE STATE DEPARTMENT IF ELECTED PRESIDENT. THE GENERAL SET FORTH HIS POSITION IN A PICNIC MEETING WITH THE 70 MEMBER PENNSYLVANIA DELEGATION TO THE REPUBLICAN NATIONAL CONVENTION.

THE GENERAL SAID: "WHEN I SAY WE NEED A NEW ADMINISTRATION, I MEAN A NEW ADMINISTRATION IN ALL ITS PARTS."

PRESIDENT TRUMAN HAS CALLED FOR A STRONG COMPULSORY CIVIL RIGHTS PROGRAM BACKED BY THE POWER OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. HE TOLD A HOWARD UNIVERSITY COMMENCEMENT AUDIENCE THAT IT IS NOT ENOUGH TO LET THE STATE OR MEN OF GOOD WILL HANDLE THE PROBLEM BY THEMSELVES.

THE PRESIDENT SAID THE US HAS PROGRESSED FAR IN REACHING A FULLER UNDERSTANDING OF THE BROTHERHOOD OF MAN. BUT, HE SAID, MUCH REMAINS TO BE DONE.

AIR FORCE SECRETARY THOMAS FINLETTER IS ON HIS WAY BACK TO WASHINGTON. SECRETARY FINLETTER INSPECTED THE FIRST AMERICAN JET BOMBER WING TO ARRIVE IN EUROPE YESTERDAY THEN LEFT FOR WASHINGTON ON "URGENT" BUSINESS. MR. FINLETTER CANCELLED A SCHEDULED TRIP TO NORWAY TO RETURN HOME.
