KOJE UNDER CONTROL

BRIG GEN HAYDON BOATNER AP-PEARS TO HAVE WON THE BATTLE FOR UNCONTESTED CONTROL OF KOJE

FOUR TOUGH COMPOUNDS. TER-RORIZED BY COMMUNIST LEADERS, SUR-RENDERED TO THE CAMP COMMANDANT AUTHORITIES YESTERDAY, GENERAL BOATHER SAID: "THE WORST IS OVER! TWO OF THE COMPOUNDS WERE CLEARED WITHOUT RESISTENCE, ANOTHER WORD IT WAS READY TO OBEY THE GEN-ERAL'S ORDERS AND A FOURTH SUR-RENDERED 21 ANTI-COMMUNIST PRIS-ONERS. GENERAL BOATNER SAYS: WILL NOT GO SO FAR AS TO SAY HE RE-SISTANCE HAS ENDED BUT HE DE-CLARES, IT IS DEFINATLY "ON THE EBB."

THE COMMANDANT SAYS HE PLANS NO MORE TRANSFERS OF INMATE'S FOR THE NEXT TWO OT THREE DAYS. SINCE TUESDAY, MORE THAN 27,000 PRISON-ERS IN SIX OF KOJE'S 17 COMPOUNDS, HAVE FITHER BEEN SHIFTED TO OTHER LARGE INCLOSURES OR BROKEN UP INTO NEW, SMALL AND MORE MANAGEABLE STOCKADES HOLDING 500 MEN

NEWS FLASHES

THE BRITISH LABOR PARTY EX-ECUTIVE COUNCIL AGAIN HAS CALLED FOR THE ADMISSION OF COMMUNIST CHINA INTO THE UNITED NATIONS.

MOSCOW HAS ANNOUNCED THAT FORMER SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED STATES, ALEXANDER PANYUSH-KIN, HAS A NEW JOB AS AMBASSADOR TO COMMUNIST CHINA. PANYUSHKIN IS ON HIS WAY HOME. NOW FROM WASHING-TON.

GENERAL EISENHOWER HAS MADE IT PLAIN THAT HE WILL CLEAN OUT THE STATE DEPARTMENT IF ELECTED PRESIDENT. THE GENERAL SET FOURTH HIS POSITION IN A PICNIC MEETING WITH THE 70 MEMBER PENNSYLVANIA DELEGATION TO THE REPUBLICAN NATIONAL CONVENTION.

THE GENERAL SAID: TWHEN I SAY WE NEED A NEW ADMINISTRATION, I MEAN A NEW ADMINISTRATION IN ALL ITS PARTS.

PRESIDENT TRUMAN HAS CALLED FOR A STRONG COMPULSORY CIVIL EIGHTS PROGRAM BACKED BY THE POWER OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. HE TOLD A HOWARD UNIVERSITY COMMENCEMENT AUDIENCE THAT IT IS NOT ENOUGH TO LET THE STATE OR MEN OF GOOD WILL HANDLE THE PROBLEM BY THEMSELVES.

member of the weater sex.


