PAGE LAUDS INFANTRY ON ANNIVERSARY

FROM WASHINGTON, ARMY SECRETARY FRANK PAGE JR. SENDS THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT TO THE MEN OF THE INFANTRY, HERE IN THE FAR EAST, AND THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.

"TO ALL OF THE MEN WHO WEAR THE BLUE BRAID AND THE CROSSED RIFLES, THE INFANTRY OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY, I SEND CONGRATULATIONS AND THANKS ON THIS 177TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INFANTRY (JUNE 15.) I SPEAK FOR YOUR COMBAT COMPANIES OF THE ENGINEERS, MEDICAL CORPS, ARMOR AND ARTILLERY, AS WELL AS FOR ALL THE OTHER BRANCHES THAT SUPPORT YOU WHEN I SAY THAT THE ARMY IS PROUD OF YOU. I AM CERTAIN THIS APPLIES TO ALL OF OUR SISTER SERVICES AS WELL.

YOU ARE THE OLDEST OF ALL THE AMERICAN FIGHTING FORCES. YOU HAVE ALWAYS DONE THE HARDEST JOB WE HAVE HAD TO DO, UNDER THE HARDEST CONDITIONS. EACH OF YOU BEARS A TREMENDOUS RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SAFETY OF AMERICA.

FOR ALL THESE REASONS WE OFFER YOU TODAY, NOT SYMPATHY, WHICH YOU DO NOT SEEK, NOR GLORIFICATION, WHICH YOU DO NOT WANT, BUT RESPECT WHICH YOU QUIETLY FEEL FOR YOURSELVES AND FOR THE COMBAT ARM IN WHICH YOU SERVE."

VICE ADM JERVAULD WRIGHT TOOK OVER AS COMMANDER IN CHIEF OF UNITED STATES NAVAL FORCES IN THE EASTERN ATLANTIC AND MEDITERRANEAN SEA IN A COLORFUL CEREMONY.

HE SUCCEEDED ADMIRAL ROBERT B. CARNEY, WHO GAVE UP THE POSITION TO DEVOTE HIS FULL TIME TO TWO IMPORTANT ATLANTIC PACT JOBS: COMMANDER IN CHIEF OF ALLIED FORCES IN SOUTHERN EUROPE, AND COMMANDER OF ALLIED NAVAL FORCES IN SOUTHERN EUROPE.

THUS FAR THERE HAS BEEN NO REPORT FROM PANMUNJOM.

ATOMIC SUB

PRESIDENT TRUMAN LIFTED A CORNER OF THE VEIL OF SECRECY YESTERDAY SURROUNDING THE WORLD'S FIRST KNOWN ATOMIC ENERGY ENGINE. HE SAID IT WILL DRIVE THE NEW US ATOM SUB, NAUTILUS, AT MORE THAN 23 MILES PER HOUR UNDER WATER.

THE PRESIDENT SAID, "IT WILL BE ABLE TO TRAVEL FOR THOUSANDS OF MILES AT TOP SPEED ON A FEW POUNDS OF URANIUM." HE DESCRIBED THE SUBMARINE AS THE FORERUNNER OF ATOMIC POWER MERCHANT SHIPS AND AIRPLANES. AND POWER PLANTS PRODUCING ELECTRICITY FOR FACTORIES, FARMS AND HOMES. THE NEW SOURCE OF POWER WOULD COME INTO USE MUCH SOONER, THE PRESIDENT POINTED OUT, IF THE US COULD DEVOTE A FULL SHARE OF ITS ENERGIES TO THE PEACETIME DEVELOPMENT OF THE ATOM. MR TRUMAN FORESAW THE DAY WHEN ATOMIC POWER PLANTS WILL BE IN WIDE PEACETIME USE.

DYNAMIC TENT POLE

THE NEW SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO THE US IS TO BE THE MAN GROMYKO IS REPLACING IN LONDON, GEORGI ZARUBIN. THE POST IN WASHINGTON WILL NOT BE THE FIRST POST IN THE WESTERN HEMISPHERE FOR ZARUBIN. HE WAS IN CANADA AT THE TIME THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT BROKE UP A BIG COMMUNIST SPY RING THERE.
