

AIDS RECON

BY SGT WAYNE LYFORD CLOSE COOPERATION BETWEEN THE INFANTRY AND FIELD ARTILLERY MAS DEMONSTRATED RECENTLY IN THE "BUF-FALO" REGIMENT SECTOR OF THE KOR-EAN FRONT. BECAUSE IT WAS A RECONNAISSANCE PATROL THEY DID NOT HAVE A SUFFICIENT SUPPLY OF AMMUNITION TO CONTINUENCE AN EFFECTIVE FIGHT. HOWEVER, EFFECTIVE FIRING BY PFC BILL GALLAGHER KEPT THE ENEMY DOWN SO THAT THEY COULD NOT EFFECTIVE FIRE. BRING

WORLD NEWS

THE UNITED NATIONS COMMAND HAS ACCUSED THE COMMUNISTS OF IN-DANGERING THE LIVES OF AMERICAN AND OTHER ALLIED NATIONALS HELD. IN

NORTH KOREAN PRISON CAMPS.

IN A FORMAL NOTE HANDED THE COMMUNIST ARMISTICE DELEGATION SUNDAY, THE ALLIES CHARGE THAT THE REDS HAVE FAILED TO MARK FIVE POW CAMPS SO THAT UN PLAMES MAY SURE OF AVOIDING THEM IN THEIR D'AILY STRIKES AGAINST COMMUNIST .TARGETS.

THE REDS HAVE INDICATED THEY ARE AFRAID OF AN INSPECTION OF AL-LIED POW CAMPS BY REPRESENTATIVES OF NEUTRAL NATIONS. COMMUNIST ISTICE NEGOTIATORS HAVE TOLD UN COMMAND THEY WILL REGARD NEUTRAL NATION INSPECTING ANY ALLIED CAMPS AS MO LONGER NEUTRAL.

PRESIDENT TRUMAN HAS SUGGEST-ED THAT REPRESENTATIVES FROM SWE-DEN, SWITZERLAND, INDIA, PAKISTAN AND INDONESIA VISIT THE CAMPS TO TESTIFY THAT THE UN COMMAND IS TREATING THEIR PRISONERS WELL.

IN GROUND FIGHTING SUNDAY, THE COMMUNISTS UNLEASHED WHAT APPEARED TO BE THEIR HEAVIEST MORTAR AND BARRAGE OF THE WAR.

THE COMMUNISTS THREW A TOTAL OF 11,763 ROUNDS OF MORTAR AND AR-TILLERY FIRE AT ALLIED POSITIONS,

MOSTLY ON THE CENTRAL FRONT.

AN EIGHTH ARMY BRIEFING OF ~ FICER SAID THIS WAS PROBABLY THE HIGHEST TOTAL FIRED BY THE EI EMY IN ANY SINGLE DAY SINCE THE START OF THE WAR.
