CHINESE TROOPS SHOWED SIGNS EARLY YESTERDAY MORNING OF SLACK-ENING THE COUNTER ATTACKS
HAVE MADE A SEVEN-DAY BATTLE
A WESTERN FRONT HILL MASS THAT FOR BLOODEST SINCE JANUARY. THE CHIN-ESE THREN A BATTALION OF ABOUT 750 SOLDIERS AGAINST ALLIED DE-DE-FENDERS FOR FIVE DAYS AFTER GIVE-ING UP THE SOTTOM END OF A "P"_ SHAPED HILL SHOUP THURSDAY NIGHT. THEY GAVE UP TUESDAY MORNING'S AS-SAULTS AFTER THREE ATTACKS FAILED TO BUIGE UN TROOPS FROM TRENCHES.

ALLIED FORCES INFLICTED AN ESTIMATER 3, 300 CASUALTIES ACROSS THE FRONT LAST WEEK, 1700 WOUNDED AND 47 CAPTURED. THE FIGURE IS THE LARGEST SINCE THE 3500 THE 15 ist -PORTED FOR THE THIRD WEEK IN JAN-UAFY.

URGE LARGER USAF

THE SEMATE PREPAREDNESS SUB-COMMITTEE YESTERDAY CALLED FOR A FASTER BUILDUP OF U.S. AIR POWER. THE SUB-COMMITTEE CITED TESTIMONY BY THE JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF AIR FORCE COMMENDING A 143-WING NOT LATER THAN THE END OF THE YEAR THEY CONSIDER TO BE THE MOST DANGEROUS FOR THE SECURITY OF THE UNITED STATES IN THE FORE-SEEABLE FUTERE.

GEN DWIGHT EISENHOWER TERDAY LASHED OUT DIRECTLY AT SENATOR TAFT FOR THE FIRST TIME. HE ACCUSED THE OHIO SENATOR BEING AN ISOLATIONIST AND THAT HE DOES NOT BELIEVE A REPUB-LICAN PARTY FOREIGN POLICY COULD BE DRAFTED WHICH WOULD BE ACCEPTABLE TO BOTH THE TAFT AND EISENHOWER FORCES.

WEST GERMANY HAS OFFERED TO PAY DAMAGES TO ISTAEL FOR MAZI CRIMES AGAINST THE JEWS. A SPOKES MAN FOR THE WEST GERMAN GOVERN-MENT SAYS GERMANY IS WILLING PAY 174 MILLION DOLLARS IN GOODS OVER A 12 YEAR PERIOD. THE GOODS WILL BE MANUFACTURED IN BEREIN KEEP BERLIN'S ECONOMY GOING THE EVENT OF A RUSSIAN BLOCK ADE.

COMMUNIST GERMANY IS PUEPATI-ING TO BEAFT GERMAN'S INTO THE ARMY AT THE POINT OF A GUN, THE EAST GERMAN GOVERNMENT SAYS CON-SCIENTIOUS OBJECTORS WILL BE RE-GARDED AS "ENEMY'S OF PEACE."
