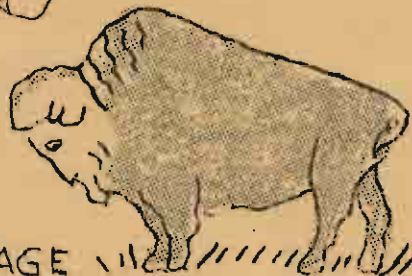
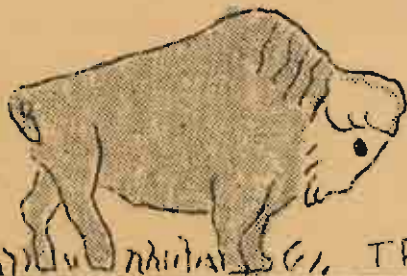

## REDS EASE UP

CHINESE REDS HAVE APPARENTLY CALLED A HALT TO THEIR COUNTER ATTACKS ON THE WESTERN FRONT.

AS OF LATE WEDNESDAY, THE REDS HAD FAILED FOR 24 HOURS TO TRY TO PUSH ALLIED TROOPS OFF THE BASE OF A "T"-SHAPED HILL WEST OF CHORWON.

IN FIVE DAYS, REPEATED, COMMUNIST ASSAULTS ON THE OBJECTIVE COST THE REDS MORE THAN A THOUSAND CASUALTIES IN KILLED AND WOUNDED.

NOT ONLY DID THE REDS LAY LOW WEDNESDAY, BUT EVEN THE THUNDERING ARTILLERY BARRAGES LET UP. A UN OFFICER WARNED, HOWEVER, THAT THIS INACTIVITY DOES NOT MEAN THE REDS HAVE GIVEN UP THEIR ATTEMPT TO DISLodge THE UN TROOPS FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE KEY FORWARD HILL GROUP.

## REFUTE GERM CHARGE

THE US CHARGES THE REDS WITH CARRYING ON A CAMPAIGN OF LIES ABOUT GERM WARFARE. THE AMERICAN DELEGATE TO THE UN SECURITY COUNSEL, GUEST GROSS, SAYS RUSSIA AND RED CHINA HAVE FALSELY ACCUSED THE US AND THE UN SO THEY CAN USE IT THEMSELVES.

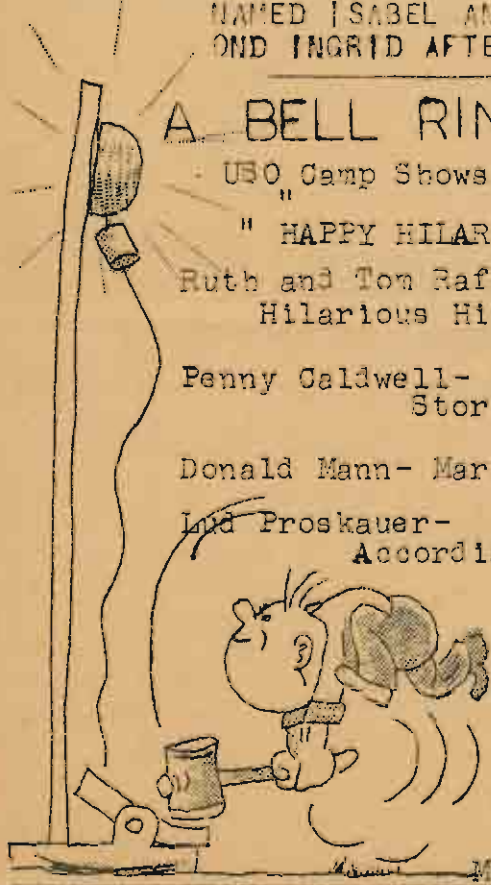

STATESIDE NEWS

UNITED MINE WORKERS PRESIDENT JOHN L LEWIS, HAS BACKED THE STRIKING CIO STEEL WORKERS WITH A 10 MILLION DOLLAR SUPPORT FUND.

LEWIS NOTIFIED CIO PRESIDENT PHILLIP MURRAY THAT THE HUGE SUM IS ON DEPOSIT IN A WASHINGTON BANK AND THAT IT CAN BE REPAID WHEN THE STEEL STRIKERS HAVE WON THEIR VICTORY.

BEFORE TO THE LEWIS SURPRISE ANNOUNCEMENT ECONOMIC STABILIZER PUTNAM PROMISED THE STEEL INDUSTRY "FRIENDLY AND SYMPATHETIC" HEARING IF THE STRIKE IS SETTLED. HE INDICATED HE WILL APPROVE A PRICE BOOST HIGHER THAN THREE DOLLARS A TON PREVIOUSLY OFFERED.

THE SENATE HAS KILLED A BILL TO AUTHORIZE THE U.S. TO JOIN CANADA IN BUILDING THE ST LAWRENCE SEAWAY AND POWER PROJECT. PRESIDENT TRUMAN MADE A LAST MINUTE APPEAL TO THE SENATE TO PASS THE BILL TO THE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE FOR FURTHER STUDY.

AVERILL HARRIMAN HAS SCORED A RUNAWAY VICTORY OVER SENATOR ESTES KEFAUVER IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA. IT WAS A PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY, WITH SIX CONVENTION VOTES AT STAKE.

HARRIMAN ROLLED UP 14,000 VOTES TO 3,300 FOR SENATOR KEFAUVER, AFTER CAMPAIGNING DOWN THE LINE FOR PRESIDENT TRUMAN'S CIVIL RIGHTS PROGRAM.

SECRETARY OF STATE DEAN ACHESON SAYS HE WAS SHOCKED AT RUSSIA'S INDEFENSIBLE ACTION IN SHOOTING DOWN AN UNARMED SWEDISH PLANE.

MR. ACHESON ALSO TOLD A NEWS CONFERENCE THAT RED AGGRESSION HAS BEEN CHECKED IN INDO CHINA. HE ADDED, THE U.S. IS WILLING TO AGREE TO A BIG FOUR CONFERENCE ON THE GERMAN PEACE PROBLEMS, HOWEVER, HE SAID HE IS NOT SURE WHETHER THE CHANCES FOR SUCH A CONFERENCE ARE GOOD NOW.

HITTING HONORS AGAIN WENT TO CENTERFIELDER CPL MILTON GAUDET WITH TWO 400 FOOT TRIPLES AND A LINE DOUBLE. THE POWERFUL LITTLE SOUTHPAW DROVE IN TWO RUNS AND CROSSED THE PLATE THREE TIMES. HE IS LEADING THE "BUFFALOES" WITH A .400 AVERAGE AT THE PLATE.

THE NEW YORK YANKEES BELTED THE DETROIT TIGERS, 10-8, IN A CONTEST THAT SAW FIVE HOMERS HIT. WALT DROPO AND VIC WERTZ CONNECTED FOR THE TIGERS, AND YOGI BERRA, CENE WOODLING AND BILLY MARTIN HOMERED FOR THE YANKEES.

FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE SIX YEAR HISTORY OF THE NCAA BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP, THE WINNERS CROWN BELONGS TO A TEAM FROM THE EAST. HOLY CROSS FROM WORCESTER, MASSACHUSETTS, WON THE WORLD SERIES OF COLLEGE BASEBALL BY DEFEATING THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI, 8-4, AT OMAHA.

IN THE PHILIPPINES, AN AMERICAN WAR VETERAN WHO BECAME A COMMUNIST GUERRILLA HAS BEEN SENTENCED TO LIFE IMPRISONMENT. WILLIAM POMEROY, OF ROCHESTER, NEW YORK, PLEADED GUILTY TO REBELLION. THE JUDGE DID NOT IMPOSE THE DEATH PENALTY, HE SAID, BECAUSE HE FELT POMEROY AND HIS NATIVE WIFE HAD REPENTED.
