

REDS EASE UP

CHINESE REDS HAVE APPARENT-LY CALLED A HALT TO THEIR COUNTER ATTACKS ON THE WESTERN FRONT.

## STATESIDE NEWS

UNITED MINE WORKERS PRESIDENT COHN L LEWIS, HAS BACKED THE STRIKING CIO STEEL WORKERS WITH A \*C MILLION DOLLAR SUPPORT FUND.

LEWIS NOTIFIED CIO PRESIDENT PHILLIP MURRAY THAT THE HUGE SUM IS ON DEPOSIT IN A WASHINGTON BANK AND THAT IT CAN BE REPAID WHEN THE STEEL STRIKERS HAVE WON THEIR VIC-TORY.


